Location and Event Dates

Whistler, British Columbia Friday, April 11 to Sunday, April 13, 2025

Sanction

ACA and BC Alpine

Eligibility

- All participants must be born in the year 2011/2012 and be qualified competitive members of their <u>own</u> club. Official representatives chosen by each recognized club may participate in the Whistler Cup U14 Festival.
- Each club may participate with a maximum of 6 athletes (3 girls and 3 boys). In addition, each PSO may enter or name up to two provincial teams with a quota of 6 athletes (3 girls, 3 boys).
- Clubs may enter a second quota if space is available.
- The individuals on a Provincial team will not score points for their club. All the participants must be members of their own club, Provincial or National team, registered with their respective Provincial or National Ski Federation and be insured.

Entry Deadline

- Entries are to be submitted by a recognized club, PSO or NSO by no later than February 28, 2025 by 5pm (PST time). Entries will be on a first come first serve basis. We will not hold spots, so please register early. Entries from individuals will not be accepted. Entries should include the following:
 - Number of participants by gender. (names can be updated until March 28, 2025)
 - Names and contact details of coaching staff who will be attending. (can be updated up to March 28, 2025)
 - All Area Competitor Pass numbers for athletes and coaches (if applicable).
 - All athletes/parents must submit their bio form and waiver by March 28, 2025 to be eligible to compete. (form available on website).

 Each Nation/Province/Club will designate one representative who will be responsible for all Whistler Cup communication with regards to entries/seeding and payment.

Fees

- The entry fee is \$600 for athletes and \$450 for coaches, before February 28, 2025. Entries received after February 28, 2025 (if space is available) will incur a \$50 late fee. Please reach out to wcregistration@wmsc.info if your athletes/coaches have Seasons/Epic/Reciprocal Passes to Whistler Blackcomb.
- Team rosters must be confirmed by March 28, 2025 to avoid a \$50 change fee. This includes coaching staff.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- There is a \$50 bib loss charge for all lost bibs.
- Payments must be made in FULL by February 28, 2025. An invoice will be sent once entries are received. Payment can be made by CDN cheque, EFT or credit card.

The payment includes:

- 4-day lift ticket (valid April 10-13, 2025)
- A meal package including all breakfasts and bag lunches from Friday April 11, 2025 through Sunday, April 13, 2025 (3 breakfast and 3 lunches).
- Dinners: Thursday Welcome Dinner at the Whistler Conference Centre and Saturday Banquet at the Whistler Conference Centre (2 dinners).
- Race entry fee.
- Helly Hansen souvenir wearable item.

Additional Lift Tickets

Additional tickets are available for **pre-purchase** for \$41.00 (incl. taxes) per day through the registration form. If you require lift tickets for additional days (from Monday, April 7, 2025 to Wednesday, April 9, 2025), they will be available for pickup at the Accreditation Office. *For athlete and coach use only*, must be ordered in advance through the registration platform.

Rules

- The U14 events are governed by FIS rules and regulations. It is the responsibility of coaches and clubs to be familiar with the rules, particularly with regards to equipment and helmets: https://www.fis-ski.com/en/inside-fis/document-library/alpine-documents
- Helmets must be worn at all times by athletes, coaches and support staff.
- No smoking on any Whistler Blackcomb property.

<u>Awards</u>

The Nations Cup will be awarded to the best Nation in SL and GS. The Team Event does not count for points. Medals will be awarded to the top 3 in each category/gender each day.

There will be trophies for best performance by a Canadian female and male. Races counting towards these trophies will be the SL and GS. The Team Event does not count towards these trophies. Points will be awarded based on the World Cup points system. The top performing Canadian female over both disciplines will receive the Nancy Greene Trophy, and the top performing Canadian male will be awarded the Dave Murray Trophy. In the event of a tie, both athletes will be awarded the trophy.
